Shillong, 16 September 2026: A Hindi Diwas Celebration was held at Durbar Hall, Lok Bhavan, Shillong, with the participation of dignitaries, officials, students and representatives from various central government institutions and organisations. Shri, H.C. Chaudhary, Additional Chief Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor of Meghalaya and Dr. B.D.R. Tiwari, I.A.S., Chief Electoral Officer, Meghalaya, were present during the program.

The program was organized by the Central Institute of Hindi Shillong in collaboration with Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) and Lok Bhavan Shillong. A video presentation on the work undertaken by the Central Institute of Hindi was screened during the programme, highlighting the training provided to Hindi teachers from different districts of Mizoram, Meghalaya and Tripura. A journal titled "*Samanvaya Purvottar*", with Prof. Parth Sarthi Pandey as its Editor-in-Chief, was also unveiled during the programme.
